PARTY The Ministry has communicated the concern of the Finance Minister with regard to the fall of Customs revenue collection in November, 2005 as compared to the earlier months. The Finance Minister has desired that a 20% growth rate for the budget estimates should be achieved during December, 2005. The Board has directed that the following measure should be taken in this regard:

- i) Daily monitoring of assessment to ensure payment of duty.
- ii) Expeditious assessment of provisional assessments.
- iii) Steps to be taken to recover realization of recoverable arrears.
- 2. Finance Minister has observed that there should be no difficulty in maximizing revenue by ensuring quick clearance of imported cargo on the day of assessment itself and in case of any difficulty clearance should be permitted on provisional basis by collecting duty thereon. • It has been directed that no effort should be spared to ensure speedy clearance of import cargo.
- 3. The directions of the Finance Minister and Board are being communicated for strict implementation. All officers should ensure that all the steps to be taken for maximizing revenue are strictly adhered to. • Joint Commissioner (Appraising Main) will ensure that daily

revenue details are communicated to ADC(KNR) by 20.00 Hrs on a daily basis. Both the Joint Commissioners will ensure strict monitoring of the groups under their charge. Dy./Asstt. Commissioner posted in the Docks should ensure expeditious clearance of cargo.
