Subject: Maintenance of Goods Registration Register and Discrepancy Register • Instructions • Regarding.

Each export shed / CFS is required to maintain a goods registration register which acts as a control register for the supervisory officers such as AC / DC, JC, Commissioner. The goods registration register should give a clear picture of the nature of goods being carted in a CFS for examination. It has been noticed that there is no uniform format in which the details of export goods carted in a CFS are captured at the time of registration of such export goods for examination.
