Attention is invited to the <u>Customs Circular No. 27/2010-Customs</u> dated 13.08.2010 & <u>Standing order 78/2010</u> dtd. 01.12.2010 regarding procedure to be followed by the Customs field formations in case of 4% CVD refund claims.

2. **ADD** The above Circular provides the facility of manual filing of Bill of Entry for utilizing the amount of re-credited 4% CVD (SAD) refunds for payment duty of re-credited DEPB Reward of in case / Scheme scrips upto 30.12.2010. However several representations have been received from trade and industry to extend the time upto 30th June 2011 for using re-credited 4% CVD (SAD) amount in DEPB as they have not been able to utilize the re-credited DEPB / Reward Scheme scrips within the stipulated time.

4. This Standing Order is issued only to extend time limit for using re-credited DEPB / Reward Scheme scrips in case of 4% CVD (SAD) upto <u>30th June 2011.</u> All the contents in <u>Standing Order No.</u> <u>78/2010</u> dated 01.12.2010 remain unchanged.
