3. ❖❖❖❖❖❖❖❖❖ As per the scheme of their notifications, export of these commodities is prohibited in the course of international trade unless it conforms to the standards applicable to the commodity under export and is accompanied by a certificate stating that the processing establishment is approved and monitored by the Export Inspection Agencies established under Section 7 of the Export (Quality Control and Inspection) Act, 1963.

4. ❖❖❖❖❖❖❖❖❖ In view of the above, export of above mentioned notified commodities is permitted only if the product are manufactured in establishments❖ approved & monitored by the Export Inspection Agencies and their consignments are covered / accompanied by a certificate of Inspection / Certificate of Export (sample copies enclosed for easy reference). The list of processing establishments approved by the EIAs, related GOI Notification and orders and other details relating to the standards applicable are already available as public information on the Export Inspection Council of India website www.eicindia.org❖

5. ❖❖❖❖❖❖❖❖❖ Hence all the field officers working under Export Commissionerate, should ensure that the above mentioned commodities should be permitted to be exported only if it is accompanied by the Certificate of Inspection issued by EIAs and the products are manufactured in the establishment approved and monitored by EIAs.

6. ❖❖❖❖❖❖❖❖❖ All concerned are directed to follow these instructions with immediate effect.
