

wood packaging material or no treatment mark on wood packaging material used in packaging of goods exported from India. They further informed that henceforth strict action would be taken against non-compliance of ISPM-15 standard by exporters from India.

5. ◆◆◆◆◆◆◆◆ Board vide Circular No.14/2009-Customs dated 06.05.2009 has directed that all the Customs field formations should verify whether the export goods packed with raw or solid wood packaging material comply with the ISPM No. 15 or are accompanied by a phytosanitary certificate with the treatment endorsed issued by the agencies which are accredited / certified by DAC. In case of non-compliance, the matter may be referred to the Plant Quarantine authorities for proper treatment of export goods before their release.

6. ◆◆◆◆◆◆◆◆ The above directions of the Board are reiterated with a view to ensure compliance by the concerned officers and staff.
