## Quarterly Preventive Maintenance Inspection For JNPT\_P-60(DTS) systems

Quarterly Preventive Maintenance Inspection (PMI) for **Drive Through** Container Scanner (DTCS) has been scheduled on 14.08.2021 starting from 09.00 A.M for 24 hours.

- 2. The officers posted at the DTCS (Road) / CSD are hereby directed that on the day of PMI, before handing over the scanner to M/s ECIL Rapiscan Ltd., all the containers waiting in queue for scanning may be cleared by them and after that they shall report to duty at MXCS, JNPCT. While taking over the scanner after completion of PMI operations, the respective Superintendent (P) / batch incharge is directed to inspect the scanner and record his observations and submit the same to the undersigned.
- 3. The staff posted at Mobile Scanners is directed to scan the containers selected for scanning at DTCS or MXCS in the following manner;
