2. At the outset the Chairman welcomed all the members and discussed the agenda points relating to Import Commissionerates first followed by agenda points of the Export/General Commissionerates.

3. The discussion & decision in respect of agenda points pertaining to NS-G & NS-II Commissionerates are as under:-

New Points

I. Instances of delay in uploading of stuffing report after LEO at JNCH

We have been informed by our members that disbursement of drawback, IGST refund etc. on certain occasions is getting delayed due to delay in uploading of stuffing report by Customs after LEO at JNCH. (List can be provided)

We seek your kind co-operation to ensure that stuffing report is uploaded in the system immediately after issuance of LEO.

Discussion:

The Chair informed that all the stuffing reports are fed into the system on the same day of receiving the Container Load Plan (CLP). However, in case of receipt of CLP in the late evening of the working day, the same is being fed into the system on the next working day. It is further informed that as on date, there is no such pendency.

Further, it is also informed by the chair that if there is any such pendency (abnormal cases)/ mismatch in container no. or seal no. the same should be brought to the notice immediately.

[Issue Closed].

II. Monitoring of dwell time of exports from Parking Plazas to Port.

As per the request made by BCBA vide letter Ref. BCBA/KS/326/2018 dated 10.07.2018 (copy attached). We kindly request to monitor the timing of movement of containers from Parking Plaza to Port Terminals. This will help to check and improve the dwell time and also will help in timely connectivity with vessels - PN No. 73/2017.

Discussion:

The Chair informed that dwell time of exports from Parking Plazas to Port is already being monitored.

II (a). Timely clearance of export cargo at Parking Plaza-Proper infrastructure and support system required

- i. Shuttle services at regular interval between the 3 terminals, parking plazas up to Karal Phata.
- ii. Canteen/ Restaurant facility/ Locker facility to be provided to the customs broker 24x7.
- iii. Fully equipped communication center with the facilities along with WIFI service to be in place.
- iv. Installation of Close Circuit Television (CCTV) for security purposes.
- v. Proper and clean washroom facilities.
- vi. Standardized procedure at all 3 terminals.
- vii. Proper working operational are required with table chair and air conditioner.
- viii. Sufficient RFID readers to be placed along with proper network for reading the RFID seals. We were also given assurances by all the authorities that common RFID readers will be made available, in place of hand devices.
- ix. Proper & timely monitoring system of all the containers gate out timing at parking plaza & gate.

Discussion:

The Chair informed that the matter has been taken up with the Manager, Parking Plazas & Terminals (Operations).

[Issue Closed].

III. Operation of RFID readers on timely basis to ensure improved dwell time

At present there is delay due to monsoon in carrying out RFID scanning process. We suggest that a mechanism be worked out to ensure that timely scanning of RFID is carried out upon entry of container at the Parking Plaza.

Discussion:

The Chair informed that all the Parking Plazas have been asked to provide better Wi-Fi connectivity for facilitating the RFID scanning process.

IV. Erratic functioning of RBI- BRC module hindering compliance of PN No 108/2018

We would like to highlight that due to erratic functioning of RBI-BRC module, there are considerable operational difficulties faced by the exporters, since banks are unable to transmit the details.

In view of the above, we kindly request you not enforce PN No. 108/2018 till the time RBI- BRC Module is fully functional

Discussion:

The Chair informed that the department is under obligation to monitor the realization of export proceeds as per extant provisions of law. This office has already communicated with Deputy Governor of RBI. The exporters are requested to communicate with their respective banks for transmitting the relevant data to customs EDI system in RBI-BRC Module. It is re-iterated that in respect of 96000 (approx.) foreign exchange realisation is shown pending in the RBI-BRC module for export shipment from 01.04.2014 till 31.12.2014. The department is in the process to generate further list of subsequent years for similar treatment.

[Issue Closed].

V. OLD POINTS could not be discussed as the members of Mumbai zone Customs Broker Association (MCBA) who had raised these points were again not present in the meeting. Therefore, the old points were disposed. The minutes of PTFC meeting covering old points was already issued on 19.07.2018.
